

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE WINE PARIS 2027 EVENT

Article 1. Definitions

The event: WINE PARIS 2027

WINE PARIS is a trade fair exclusively dedicated to beverage producers and distributors. Producers, merchants, cooperatives and distributors refer solely to companies that sell wines, spirits, ciders, beers or other beverages.

Dates: 15 to 17 February 2027

The organiser: **WINE PARIS VINEXPO PARIS**, with capital of €270,000, whose registered office is located at 17 quai du Président Paul Doumer – 92400 Courbevoie, registered with Nanterre RCS under number 842 680 845.

ORIAS number: 23001771

The venue: PARIS EXPO PORTE DE VERSAILLES

Article 2. Specific provisions for 'REBOOKING'

This exhibition does not include rebooking.

Article 3. Specific provisions for participation in WINE PARIS (excluding the Be Spirits and Be No areas)

- **10 April 2026:** registration deadline to benefit from priority reallocation of the 2026 location (unless a change of hall is imposed by the Organiser).

- **From 11 April 2026:**

- Allocations will be made on a 'first come, first served' basis.
- No cancellations or reductions in floor space will be possible.

- **15 October 2026:** deadline for cancelling stand design orders.

- **Registration confirmation:** upon payment of the first 40% deposit upon receipt of the invoice.

- Exhibitors in Hall 1 must dismantle their stands within 24 hours.

Article 4. Insurance

The insurance certificate form signed by your insurance company must be returned to the Event Organiser in order to obtain, upon express request, the cancellation/refund of the rental risk/property damage insurance offer, either by post to the Organiser's address given in Article 1 or by email to the following contact address: support-paris@vinexposium.com

Article 5. Personal data

Article 6. Location

Customers must be located in the area corresponding to their country, production region or product type for Be Spirits in order to offer visitors the best possible experience. As some areas fill up quickly, priority is given to customers who register first. Once an area is full, no further registrations will be accepted and any requests will be placed on a waiting list.

Due to the continuous growth of the Event and the adjustments required each year (in particular changes to the halls), it is not possible to sell stands based on the floor plan.

The location takes into account a number of factors: stand dimensions, number of open sides, geographical origin, safety standards, number of producers per region, etc.

The order of priority for stand allocation is as follows:

1. Technical constraints of the halls
2. Inter-professional organisations and national pavilions
3. Date of registration
4. Size of the stand
5. Technical constraints of the stand
6. Number of open sides

Article 7. Workshops and Conferences

The theme of the workshop or conference (masterclass, speech, Academy, etc.) must be communicated by the Client to the Organiser no later than two months before the start of the Event. If the theme is not received within this period, it will be considered cancelled and invoiced in accordance with the terms set out in Article 2.4.2 of the general terms and conditions of sale for communication tools.
